

ABOUT

The Takanabe Museum of Art is located in Takanabe Town, which has been known as a domain of education since the Edo period. It is operated by the smallest municipality in Miyazaki Prefecture in terms of area, and is located inside a water-filled castle moat. The museum opened on November 3, 1999, as a place of relaxation for the town's people and as a starting point for the town's development. Since its opening, the museum has made a variety of efforts centering on research and study of local artists, including those associated with Saito City and Koyu County, and the collection and exhibition of their works. The museum's 6,990




square meter grounds, including the museum building, are home to a variety of flowers and trees, including "Takanabekaido", and offer seasonal views and a traditional atmosphere.

COLLECTION

The museum's collection consists of approximately 800 works (including approximately 200 works on deposit), including paintings, prints, sculptures, crafts, and photographs by artists from Japan and abroad, with a focus on works by artists from Miyazaki Prefecture. The museum also regularly exhibits works by Kojima Torajiro, an artist associated with Takanabe Town and a painter from Nariwa Town, Takahashi City, Okayama Prefecture. Kojima Torajiro married Ishii's daughter, Tomo, because of his association with Ishii Juji (born in Takanabe Town), who founded the first orphanage in Japan. For this reason, he visited Miyazaki many times and is one of the most important artists associated with the region for the museum.


